The minutes of the meeting are as under:

1. At the outset, Dir. (EPM) informed that around 400 e-mails have been received from employees by CE(D) regarding their comments on the draft Cadre Review Report. He presented a gist of the e-mails to the Committee.
2. Dir.(EPM) informed that most of the Engg. Assistant (about 100 e-mails) suggested that merger of different cadres should be as per similar functions and responsibilities of the cadres. They suggested merger of the following cadres:
 - a) Sr. Engg. Asstt. & Assistant Engg.
 - b) Technician & Sr. Technician
 - c) Diesel Technician & Mast Technician
3. He further informed that many of prospective Broadcast Engineers want that there should be a fast track (50:50) for promotion by Departmental Examination from the cadre of Broadcast Engineer to Broadcast Executive with a ration of 50:50 vis-à-vis Selection-cum-Fitness quota.
4. Dir. (EPM) intimated that there are number of e-mails from Engg. Assistants who stated that on the one side we are going in for Digitalization under 11th Plan, whereas on the other side, a relaxation has been proposed in qualification criteria for promotion from Broadcast Executive to JTS level.
5. Dir.(EPM) informed that the following suggestions were also received through e-mails.
 - a) Higher Grade Pay for Engg. Assistant (Rs.4800/-) as asked for by Transmission Executive in their Cadre Review.


- b) ACP be introduced.
- c) Examination has been requested by almost all the mailers, wherever it is applicable. Suggestions for increase in Examination Quota has been received.
- d) IB(E)S Officers suggested that promotion quota for JTS to STS of IB(E)S should be kept at 50% .
6. The following points were raised by Members of the Committee representing Associations:

ARTEE: They suggested that wherever Direct Recruitment is there in the cadres of Sub-ordinate Engineers Cadres like Technician and Engg. Assistant, it should be continued.

ADTEA: They pointed out that they have certain reservations on issues concerning Sub-ordinate Engineering Cadres and IB(E)S.

ADTEA sought time from the Committee to take up the issues in their Association Meeting and would submit their suggestions to the committee by 28th April, 2009. Chairman agreed to the request.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
