Update of Helper's Case in Delhi High Court

Today our association's case vide W.P.(C) No. 10218/2015 was fixed for hearing along with connected Writ Petition Nos. 10215 and 5597/2015. General Secretary appeared in person, accompanied by Sh. Shyam Veer (ZS-NZ) Sh. Prashant Maheshwari & Sh. Sagir and himself argued the matter on two legal points.

Firstly that the UOI has not approached the court with clean hands because Review Application No. 219 of 2014 was dismissed on the grounds of merits & delay, which fact has been concealed in above Writ Petition. However, Hon'ble Judges told the General Secretary that in other two Writ Petitions, the said fact had been mentioned.

Secondly, General Secretary Pointed out that the scope of Writ Petition under Article 226 of Constitution is very limited and the UOI has not pointed out any error in the judgement which is apparent on the face of record and in Writ jurisdiction disputed facts cannot be gone into.

Govt's counsel Sh. Rajeev Sharma was very much present in the court as claimed to be absent by some people on FB & What's App.

Next date of hearing is fixed on 20/07/2016. General Secretary will soon file an RTI application to get to the root of the matter.
