Subject : Necessary training for Helpers who do not possess requisite qualification as per recommendations of 6th Pay Commission – Placement of all the Helpers in Group 'C' from Group 'D' and up-gradation of Grade Pay to Rs. 1800/- in Pay Band I .


As per the discussions held in the meeting DG, AIR had with the representatives of NFADE on 17th July, 2009, it was decided that an order is to be issued from Directorate giving instructions to Station Heads to immediately conduct the training programme for Helpers who do not possess the requisite qualification and are placed in 1S Pay Band, i.e. between Rs. 1300-1650. After the completion of the necessary training as per the recommendations of 6th Pay Commission, such Helpers may be placed in Group 'C' from Group 'D' in the Pay Band I with Grade Pay of Rs. 1800/-. The Helpers who are already qualified having ITI Certificate will also be placed in Group 'C' from Group 'D' in the Pay Band I with Grade Pay of Rs. 1800/-. For such category of Helpers, training is not required. Station Directors/Heads of Offices are advised to co-ordinate, supervise and ensure that the training for the Helpers is convened as per schedule given below.

The following schedule be scrupulously followed by all the Stations in a time-bound manner :

1. The training for Helpers who do not possess the requisite qualification as per recommendations of 6th Pay Commission should be conducted within a week from the issue of this order by the Station Heads.
2. After the completion of training, **orders** for fixation of pay in Pay Band I with Grade Pay of Rs. 1800/- for all the Helpers either who would be given training or those who are already qualified(having ITI Certificate) may be issued within one week from the date of convening of training. All the Helpers may be placed in the cadre of Group 'C' from Group 'D'.
3. Regional DDGs should send a Compliance Report to Directorate after the issue of Pay fixation orders in respect of all the Helpers in their respective zones.
4. This exercise, by all means, be completed before 21st August, 2009.

Station Heads are advised to comply with these directions and a report be submitted to Directorate for further necessary action.
